1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority will be PENNANT NINE YACHT CLUB.

2. RULES

The race will be sailed under Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, available of www.sas.org.za, the South African Sailing prescription thereto and the NKA handbook. The Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) 2021-2024 and all Class Rules will apply.

All competitors are to comply with any COVID19 restrictions in place at the time.

Any boat without working navigation lights will be disqualified immediately and will be required to leave the course immediately and will be scored DNC.

3. ENTRIES

Every Owner and/or Skipper of a yacht shall be members in good standing of a Yacht Club, which must be in good standing with South Africa Sailing (SAS). All yachts are to have the following:

- Working Navigational Lights during the hours of darkness;
- Life Jackets for ALL person on board to be worn by all during the hours of darkness if the wind speed is over 15 k/h.
- All yachts to have radios tuned to Channel Nine (9), or cell phones pre-coded to NSRI. **PLEASE NOTE** that a Whatsapp group will also be setup for all Bridge and Mark Boats, and competitors are welcomed and encouraged to join for updated information.
- Yachts over 9 meters must have a C.O.F. and a licensed Skipper on board.

Scrutinizing will be carried out at random and all owners / skippers will make themselves and their yachts available if requested to do so. Any yacht not complying with the above will be subject to disqualification.

4. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the notice board at Lake Deneysville Yacht Club (LDYC) and Pennant Nine Yacht Club (PNYC)

5. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes in the sailing instructions will be posted before 10h00 on the 14 May 2022 on the Race WhatsApp Group

6. SCHEDULE OF RACE

Race will start at 15h30 on the 14 May 2022 between the Bridge Boat and the Big Bend Mark. The Finish will be indicated by the Bridge Boat showing a BLUE FLASHING light, at the Big Bend Mark

7. THE COURSE

a. As each mark is rounded, competitors are required to drop a pin on the WhatsApp racing group in order to verify their position. Make sure that you have a fully charged cell phone/s available to do this. If you do not drop a pin around every mark, you will be deemed not to have sailed that leg.

The FINISH will be between Big Bend (**Green Light**) and the Bridge Boat to **STARBOARD**, which will have a **BLUE FLASHING LIGHT**, unless deemed shortened at a previous mark of the course.

Please shine a torch on your sail number and identify yourself to the marshal

8. THE START

There will be ONE start. The race will be started according to rule 26. The Class Flag will be PINK.

The starting line will be between the Bridge Boat and the Big Bend Mark.

9. THE FINISH

10. The FINISH will be between Big Bend (**Green Light**) and the Bridge Boat to **STARBOARD**, which will have a **BLUE FLASHING LIGHT**, unless deemed shortened at a previous mark of the course.

11. TIME LIMIT

The cut-off time will be at 03:30am on the 15 May 2022. Yachts failing to finish within this time will be scored DNF (Did not Finish).

12. PROTESTS

Protests shall be written on forms available at PNYC and handed in to the Race Officer or PNYC Office before 08:30am on the 20 January 2022.

Protests will be heard in the order that they are received.

Decisions of the protest committee will be final.

13. PRIZES

The RON ROSEVEARE floating trophy will be given to the winner on handicap, together with RRNR medals to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd boats on handicap.
